What to expect at the show?

Riders will be showing off their equitation skills individually and in a group.

Class One – Equitation on the Flat

This is a judged class where riders compete in a group. They will be judged on their riding position as well as overall control of the horse.

Class Two – Equitation over Poles/Fences

This is a judged class where riders will compete individually over a course of poles. Riders will be judged on their riding position as well as overall control of the horse. Riders who have been jumping consistently in lessons will be jumping a course of fences.

Spring lesson plans will be geared towards preparing students for the schooling show. If you are planning to participate in the show we recommend coming to all of your regularly scheduled lessons.
